Dear Boris:

Just as we suspected, we learned at the American Express in Nice yesterday that travel to Scandinavia is very crowded after July 1st. So we made a reservation as follows: We leave Nice at 1155 on Monday 8 July, arrive at Copenhagen 1425 that day. We plan to stay there for three days because we have not been there for a good many years and want to visit that city again. We asked Am Express to make a hotel reservation for us and by tomorrow afternoon should know at which hotel we will stay. We leave Copenhagen at 1115 on Thursday 11 July and arrive in Stockholm at 1305. We have asked Am Express to reserve a room at the Apollonia. We stay overnight there and take the 1000 boat the next morning for Sandhamn.

How will the foregoing fit in with your plans? I hope they will be OK but in case there is some conflict you can get in touch with us before leaving Menton by phoning Carola or the Apartment Office 35.80.44 ^{After} or by calling us at the hotel in Copenhagen or Stockholm. Before mailing this letter I should know the exact details and will append them.
