An outline of the information regarding the decrypting of foreign codes obtained by contacting the Germans:

1. They are concentrating on the decrypting of American diplomatic code and are obtaining a lot of valuable information from the STRIP, CIPHER, and BROWN.
2. In order to decrypt additives, they have begun to study decrypting by means of machines and they have called for 10 or more expert mathematicians.
3. No great change as far as Russian codes are concerned.
